ABOUT US

Akshara International School (AIS), one of leading schools of Pune, is a co-educational private school affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi. Being located near Hinjewadi Information Technology Park, it caters to a community of highly educated and well-travelled parents who expect world class quality education for their wards with Indian value system. The school was set up with the aim of meeting this expectation by developing the students holistically into global citizens with good human values and 21st century life skills.

The journey started in the summer of 2007, when Akshara began as a pre- primary school to make 'happy early learners' by providing them with a wide range of experiences. In 2010, the school shifted to its current campus at Wakad(a suburb of Pune) to embark on a journey to touch more lives for years to come.

At its inauguration, it was blessed by the first woman President of India, Hon. Smt. Pratibha Devisingh Patil whose public work and leadership is an inspiration to the management and staff.

Today, AIS stands tall in a sprawling campus of 3 acres with the school infrastructure supporting all aspects of its holistic (intellectual, physical, logical and spiritual) development program.

Introduction to Formal Schooling Primary Years

21st century Education

Primary

The curriculum is based on the NCERT guideline, albeit with several innovations which are introduced after much research.

The focus is on holistic development (physical, intellectual, logical and spiritual) of the child through a broad multidisciplinary and balanced curriculum to enable learning through a structured schooling program.

The teaching approach is centered around activity-based experiential learning to stimulate the development of multiple intelligences, inherent in each child.

We do this by adopting the modern methods of teaching like use of LCD projectors, Audio-Visual, Story Method, Exploration and Research, Group Discussions (Debate) to make learning effective and an enjoyable experience.



Secondary

In the Secondary section, the curriculum and pedagogy focus is on equipping our students with life skills and 21st century competencies beside holistic development.

The curriculum followed in Secondary classes is according to CBSE guidelines and NCERT curriculum.

Integrated studies, sometimes called interdisciplinary studies, brings together diverse disciplines in a comprehensive manner, enabling students to develop a meaningful understanding of the complex associations and influences within a topic. This endeavour involves extensive research and enhances the creativity, innovation, time management skills and social skills of the students.

Activity based learning: Every topic in all subjects is reinforced with research based, skill based or hands-on activities.

Use of ICT: The class room learning experiences are supported by audio visual aids like Powerpoint presentations, Audio /Video clippings etc.

Microsoft Teams: Notes and assignments are regularly uploaded on Microsoft teams for students, as a revision exercise.

Sports options: Sports options offered are Foot ball , Basket ball , cricket , archery , Badminton and Volley ball.

At the senior secondary level , the school offers Science, Commerce and Humanities streams) with broad selection of subjects choices.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Akshara follows an activity based, experiential learning approach to stimulate the development of multiple intelligences. The school program aims to bring out the inherent talent in each child through a wide range of curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular (e.g. sports, performing arts) activities.

Classrooms (Digitally Enabled for Learning)



Akshara classrooms are digitally enabled with smart board, projector and computer to supplement the traditional classrooms teaching with audio-visual aids.

Each child has secure cubby to keep his books so that all books need not be carried home and thus the school bag weight gets reduced.

The pre-primary classes are designed for activity based learning with corners like a Reading Corner with story books.

Amphitheatre (a Hub for Cultural Activities)

The school has an amphitheatre in the center of its building wherein morning assembly is conducted.

Various co-curricular activities and inter house competition are regularly hosted here amidst a competitive but energy filled environment.

Children practice and perform on the stage from pre-primary onwards which develops communication skills and helps in removal of stage fear.

Auditorium



The school auditorium has seating capacity of 520 and is equipped with state of the art sound and stage lighting systems.

The stage has been designed to give students high quality theatre experience so that they get exposure to not only acting but also to stage operations as part of their drama classes.

Inter-house competition like debates and life skill workshops are hosted here.

Library (a Knowledge Resource Centre)

For development of good language skills, Akshara believes that children should develop the love for reading books from an early stage. For this at pre-primary level we have Reading Corner in each class. At the primary level we have introduced concept of a class library wherein a set of age appropriate books are issued from the central library to each section.

The school library is well equipped with books, digital resources and a large reading room.

National Library Day is celebrated on 12th of August every year in memory of Dr. S.R. Ranganathan, an exceptional librarian and mathematician. We do activities like DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) on this day besides organizing quizzes and literary games.

Computer Labs

The School has two well equipped computer labs for imparting ICT knowledge. The school has one computer per child policy and the school computer lab is adequately equipped for the same. Science Labs



The school has well-designed separate science labs for Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects, which are fully equipped as per the guidelines laid by CBSE.

Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL) has recently been set up in the school with the objective of creating a scientific temperament as well as cultivating the spirit of curiosity and creativity among our young students. The student will be exposed to emerging technologies like Robotics, Internet of Things, 3-D printing and drones through practical hands-on experiments.

Play Areas



Segregated and age appropriate play areas have been created for outdoor and indoor sports activities.

The one acre play ground has a football zone and fenced basketball court. An indoor hall is equipped for table tennis, chess and carom.

The pre-primary outdoor play area has rubberized flooring for safety of the students

Masti Ki Pathshala is an indoor play zone designed for playful activities and learning through exploration. It has play equipment, doll house, library and music corner.
